Comments:

A brilliant day for running. Good temperatures and some drainage on the course after heavy rain all week left the going heavy especially on the route down from Lilla Cross. As I understand it there was a good group in the leading pack as they left the woodland and headed up towards York Cross. Paul Butler (the course record holder) Cameron Taylor and the Knavesmire trio of Chris Roberts, Giles Hawking, Simon Collins plus Dan Middlemas were now clear of the following group which included Kay Neesam the leading woman. In the women's event Kay was being pursued by Nicola Kent and Rhonna Haslam. As they progressed to Lilla Cross there was a choice of routes and Paul and Cameron were clear by a short distance. On the traverse across to John's Cross everyone was taking a quite different route which resulted in the pursuing Knavesmire group reforming near the cross after errors in navigation.

Dan progressed on his home territory but Paul and Cameron were now well clear with Cameron choosing the better route at the cross. Cameron went on to win from Paul and Dan. In the women's event Kay went on to win from Nicola. Rhonna lost a bit of ground and came in just ahead of her team mate Hester Butterworth. This gave Scarborough the team event with Sue Haslam their third counter. In the men's team it was Esk Valley who won comfortably so well done to Nick Wooley in his first event. New Marske H. were runners up in both men's and women's events so well done Colin Scollay who despite a head injury completed their team. Dave
